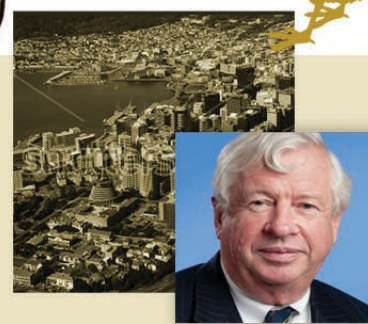
### CANADA
